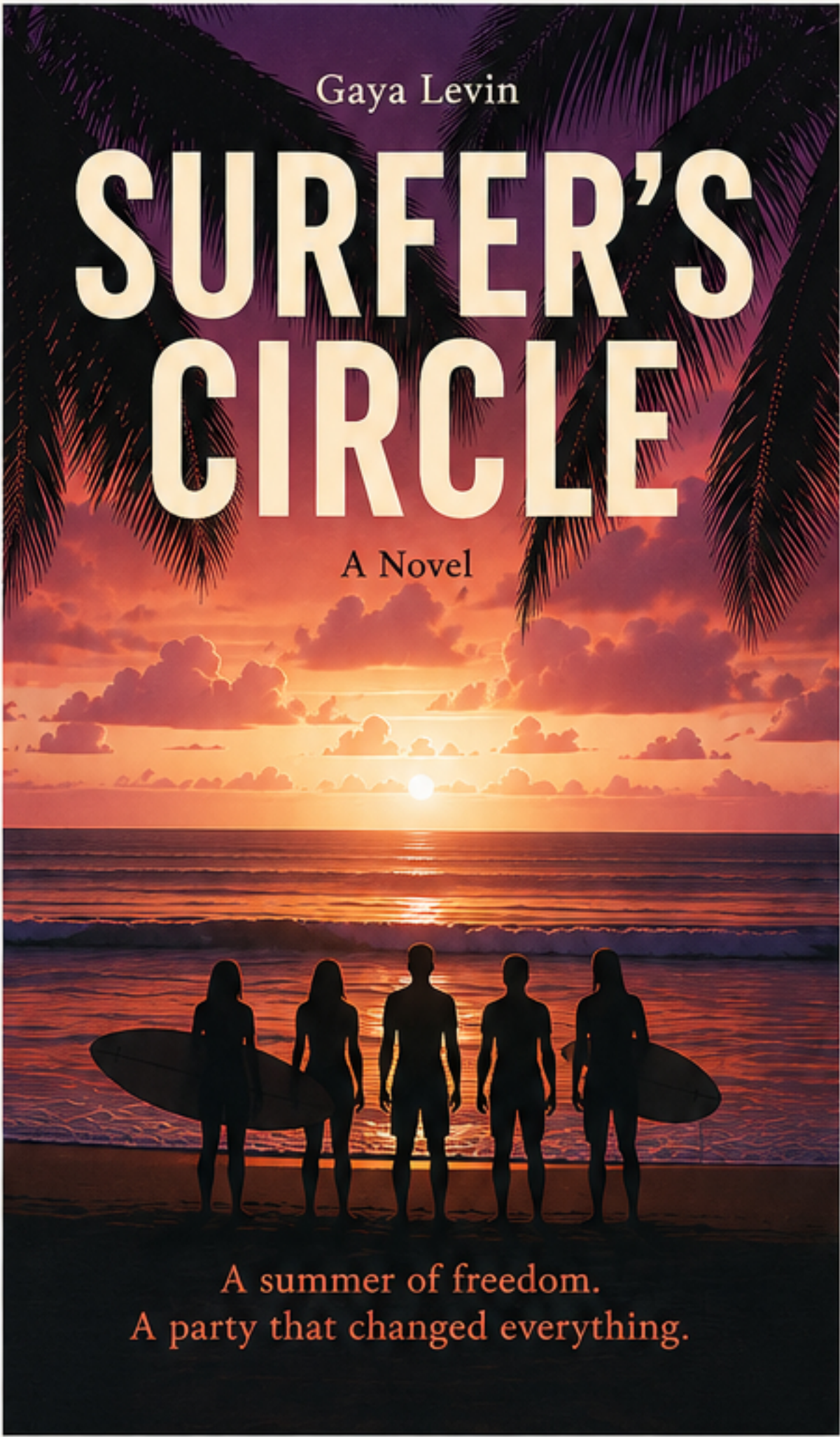




SURFER'S CIRCLE
